### IMPORTANT RODEO DAY REMINDERS

- Be ready at the gate when your name is called. We move fast so don't chance getting turned out.
- Be in dress code with your back number the entire rodeo in and out of the arena.
- Parent/ adult helpers must be Associate members of CHSRA to assist in rodeo tasks. This can be taken care of at check in for \$10.00
- Parent/ adult helpers must be in dress code in and around the arena when helping contestants.
- Treat your horses and all livestock humanely. (no hitting, schooling at the rodeos)
- No riding bareback, double, or in halters. We need to keep in mind our safety.
- No children under the age of 11 or 6<sup>th</sup> grade aloud to ride horses at High School Rodeo. This is a state policy.
- Parents cannot speak to judges, arena directors, or event directors. The contestant must be the one to clarify themselves to the student director only.
- No cursing or foul language. (This goes for the parents and spectators as well)
