Steve Pulcheon suggested District 8 T-Shirts be sold at rodeos this year as an ongoing fundraiser.

Policy and Bylaws will need to be changed to clarify Adult and Student Officer elections. An outside or non-biased person will be chairperson. Only High School Members and Associate Members are eligible to vote. An accurate list of the membership as of election date will be provided to Election Chairperson. Ballots will be mailed out to voting members, and will be returned by mail for counting. Ballots must be numbered using red ink.

The addition of student work crews at fundraising events must be included as a member responsibility. The selling of first aid kits must be added as a mandatory fundraising requirement.

It was reiterated that all members, including Associate Members and Judges, must be in Dress Code at the rodeo.

Associate Memberships must be accurately recorded by the Membership Secretary. Steer Wrestling Hazers must be Associate Members.

Kickoff Barbeque and Potluck, Membership Drive will be held on August 22. The barbeque will get started at 3:00 p.m. Lynn stated he will work on getting the meat donated. Jo Ellen and Jodi will work out potluck details. The Board of Directors will meet at 1:00 p.m.
